

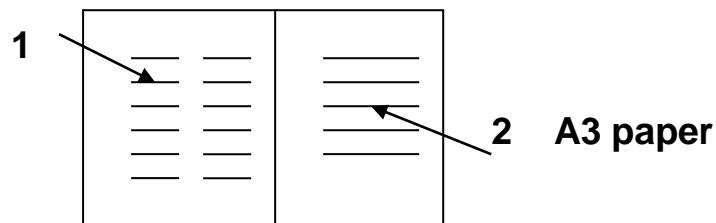
Year 10 Project – please put instructions on the board, students have their own art packs with paper and should have a pencil.
