






A mural Thank You X completed recently in Los Angeles



Now it is our turn - we will take Thank You X's idea and use this with another style of art to create a mural. This mural will be on display for our Book Character Day.



Steps:

- 1. Take your cube. Cut this out very carefully leaving the outlines of the cube.
 - 2. You will now need a thin tipped sharple to do the next part.
 - 3. Look at the ZENTANGLE art and begin making patterns using:
 - Thin lines
 - Thick lines
 - Smooth lines
- 4. Create patterns ever so carefully, so this will stand out on your cube:
- Zig-zags, spirals and so on (see the ideas)
- 5. Keep the top part blank. You will only 'zentangle' the 2 sides.
- 6. Add in your first name to your cube.






What is ZENTANGLE?

The **Zentangle** Method is an easy-to-learn, relaxing, and fun way to create beautiful images by drawing structured patterns. We call these patterns, tangles. You create tangles with combinations


of dots, lines, simple curves, S-curves and orbs.










What could Zentangle look like on a cube?
