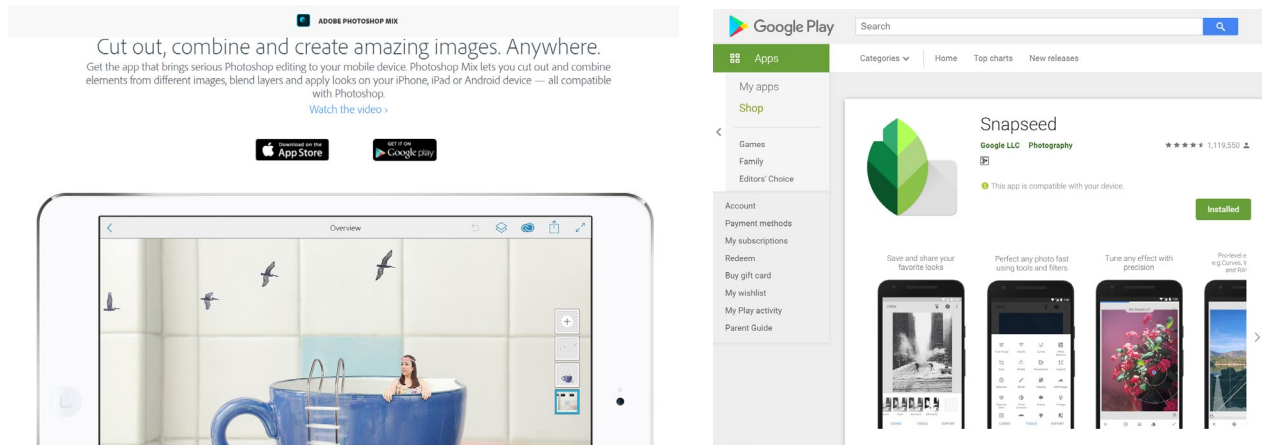


Suggestion of the Day: Multiple Exposure

Lightroom is awesome for editing photos, but it does not do layers and multiple images – this is a Photoshop function. No laptop to run Photoshop, no problem - there are other apps you can use to create Multiple Exposures.

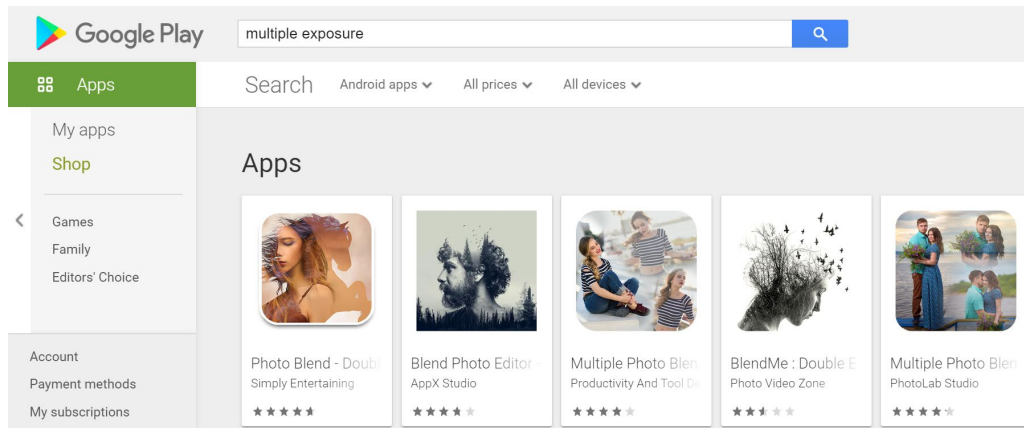
On any device

You can use **Photoshop Mix** to combine images, however I recommend **Snapseed** – it is made by Google so is add free and best of all is available on both Android and Apple platforms, including Chromebooks.



Android or Chromebook

If you do not like Snapseed, search in the Play Store for Multiple Exposure and there are loads of other options.



iPad or iPhone

If you do not like Snapseed, these two are worth a try.
