This is a two period activity and must be finished by the bell or for homework.

- 1. Take one Art New Zealand Magazine
- 2. Write down the Issue number
- 3. Find <u>three</u> artworks with people or animals in them.
- 4. Write down the Artists Names, the Names of the artwork (title) and the page numbers you found them on.
- 5. Choose <u>one</u> artwork and write a story/Narrative to go with the picture. Your story should fill 1 refill page.

Use the following questions as ideas to get you started;

- What is happening in the picture?
- Who are the people in the picture?
- What might have happened before?
- What could happen next?

Use your eyes and your imagination to write a creative story for the artwork!

If you finish your story, draw a copy of the artwork on the back of your page.
