Artists like to tell stories with their work; in art this is called a Narrative.

This is a two period activity and must be finished by the bell or for homework.

1. Take one Art New Zealand Magazine
2. Write down the Issue number
3. Find three artworks with people or animals in them.
4. Write down the Artists Names, the Names of the artwork (title) and the page numbers you found them on.
5. Choose one artwork and write a story/Narrative to go with the picture. Your story should fill 1 refill page.

Use the following questions as ideas to get you started;

- What is happening in the picture?
- Who are the people in the picture?
- What might have happened before?
- What could happen next?

Use your eyes and your imagination to write a creative story for the artwork!

If you finish your story, draw a copy of the artwork on the back of your page.
