1. ANZAAE Constitution

Motion: To proceed, under Section 33.1 of the <u>current (2021) Constitution</u> of Aotearoa-New Zealand Association of Art Educators (ANZAAE) Incorporated - Te Rūnanga Hautū Mātauranga Toi O Aotearoa, with formally replacing the Society's legal governance document with a co-governance, dual whare structure and Rules - consistent with the values and purpose of the Society - which meets the requirement of the Incorporated Societies Act 2022.

Guide to the Incorporated Societies Act

33.1 The Society may alter or replace these Rules at a Society Meeting by a resolution passed by a two-thirds majority of those Members present and voting.
