


ARTISTIC RESEARCH Task 2

Perspective: Life in Ruins
Man made structures in nature

<u>Take photos</u> of abandoned or deteriorating man made structures where nature is claiming back space. Houses, bridges, industrial buildings, boats, cracks in the foot path.

Research and collect images online that interest you in this topic. Old castles, houses, factories, hospitals, parks. Abandoned objects, cars, chairs, instruments, temples, statues, war planes, trains. They could be underwater, in jungles or still in urban environments. Practice pencil drawing techniques. Use organic pencil marks (Cross hatch, scribbling, stippling) to explore the natural elements. Use line and tone to explore the man made elements.

They could be of nature: Sunset, bird in a tree, a flower, an insect Or people in your "bubble"

A pet

An object that makes you feel good (for me it's a duck egg blue coffee mug) Food

Take photos to use as objects of reference, if the subject is living or changeable.

Create these drawings in pencil, colour, or with wet mediums. Use the internet to research drawing/painting techniques. There are a lot of great online tutorials for drawing skills le: If drawing a pet, think of tone and the direction of your pencil marks to create fur.


