
Create a colour wheel using things you can find around the house, like the example below...



## Here is what you need to do...

**Option ONE,** collect as many objects from around the house, put them on the floor in the circle and then take a photo from above, like you are a bird looking down! Save your photo in your Photos folder in your visual Art folder.

**Option TWO,** if you find it hard to get enough objects showing all the colours, you can go around the house taking photos and then construct the circle/colour wheel on word, photo shop etc. Save this in your Visual Art file.

## Steps to take...

- To get some inspiration spend a little time looking through google image, it would be a good idea to copy and paste whatever images you have used to inspire you with your final colour wheel...

- 2. Now start walking around your house, what can you see, what can you use? Now make your decision, **Option ONE or TWO?**

**Start creating**... If you are doing **Option ONE**, take atleast **10 photos** to show how you got to the final colour wheel, these show show the rearranging and moving around of the objects. Annotate appropriately.

If you are doing **Option TWO** put the photos **you will use** to create the colour wheel in your page.


I want to see the **process** you went through! Annotate appropriately.
