The main point of focus is the company icon. The viewer's eye is drawn into the design by the leading lines at the top left as the composition has been arranged diagonally from left to right.

The **colours that are dominant** are pink, yellow and blue. The artist has used these vivid colours to create an impact in strong contrast to the grey face and black background.
