

Create a geometric nameplate using geometric shapes

Materials:

A4 paper, scissors, glue stick, selection of coloured paper

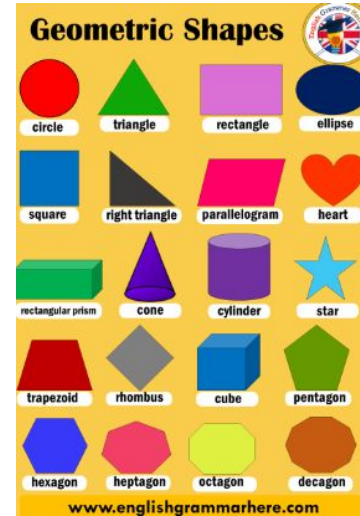
Learning Outcome:

To create a nameplate using geometric shapes.

Instructions:

1. Select some coloured paper - two or three colours that work well together.
2. Cut some geometrical shapes out. Make sure they are similar in size. You may want to rule a strip and draw the shapes first.
3. Experiment with creating letter forms with the shapes.
4. Glue your name plate down onto a piece of A4 paper.
5. **Extension activity: On an A4 piece of paper** Create your own alphabet. To do so you need to set some rules for consistency. For example, limit the colours and the shapes you use.
