Create a geometric nameplate using geometric shapes

Materials: A4 paper, scissors, glue stick, selection of coloured paper

Learning Outcome:

To create a nameplate using geometric font by using geometric shapes.

Instructions:

- 1. Select some coloured paper (two or three colours that work well together).
- 2. Cut some geometrical shapes out. Make sure they are similar in size. You may want to rule a strip and draw the shapes first.
- 3. Experiment with creating a font with the shapes.
- 4. Glue you name plate font down onto a piece of A4 paper.
- 5. Extension activity: On an A4 piece of paper
 Create your own alphabet fonts. To do, you need to set some rules for yourself. Limit the colours you use and the shapes you use. Have a look at the examples provided. I look forward to seeing what you create.
