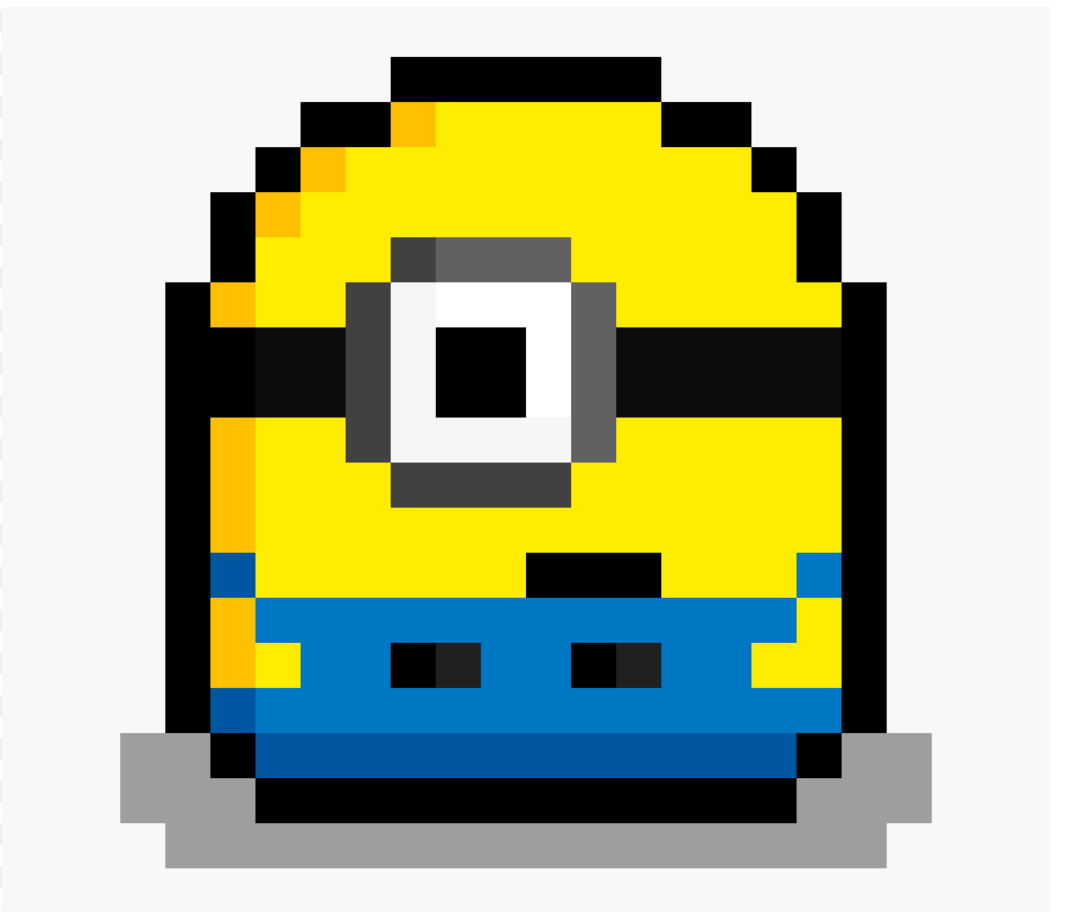
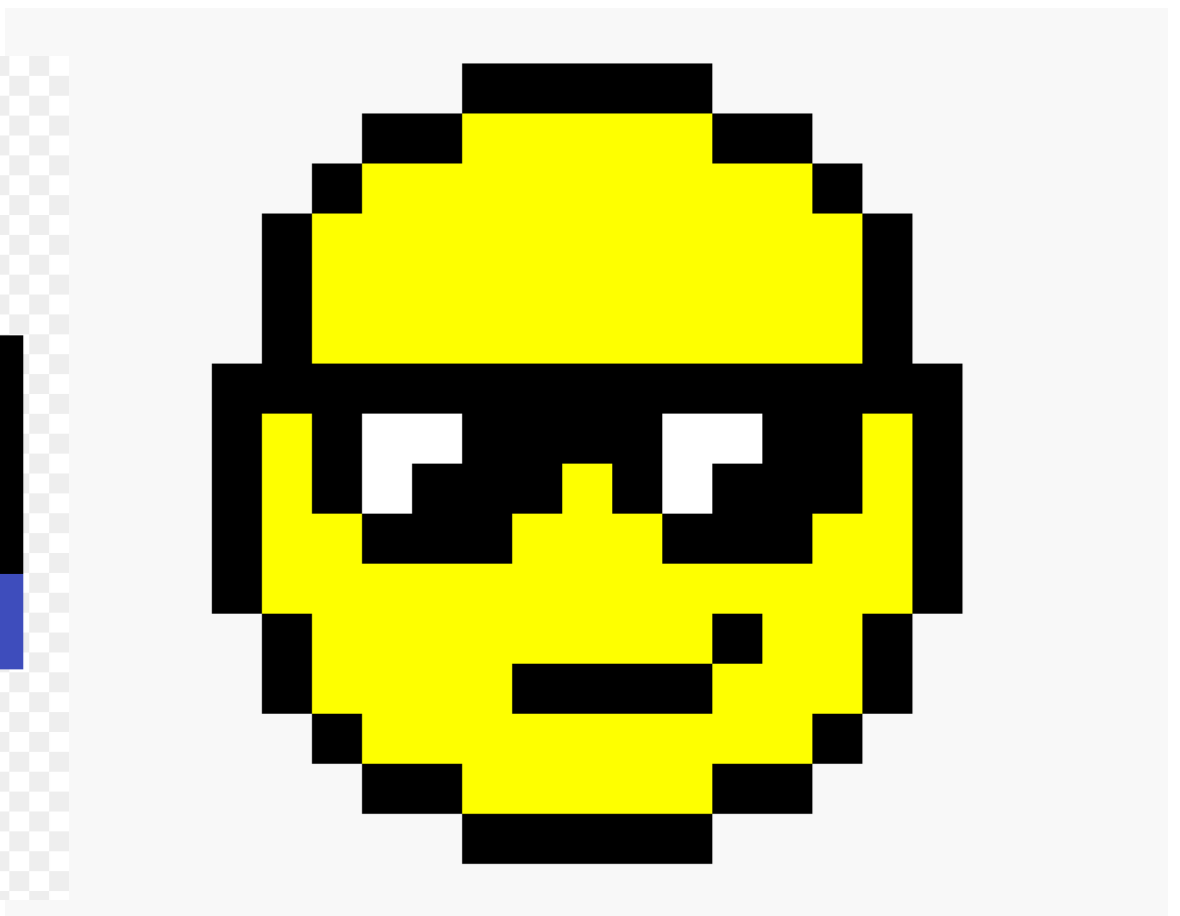
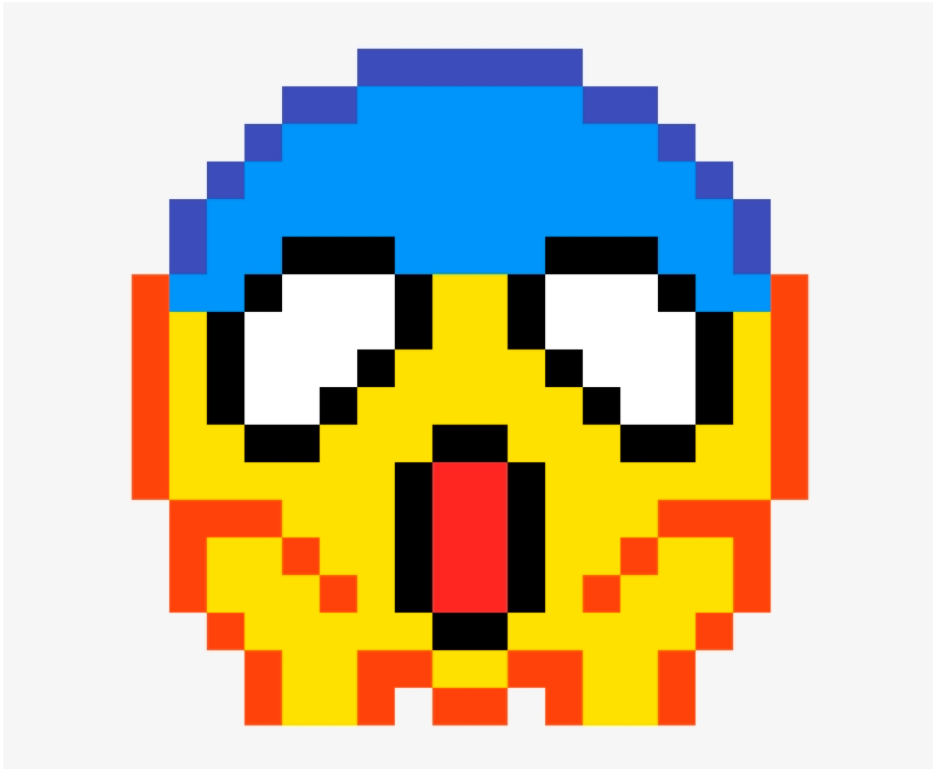
Task 1

As a class watch a presentation on the French Street Artist 'Invader'. You will then use the following steps to create your own 'Invader' inspired pixel invasion piece.

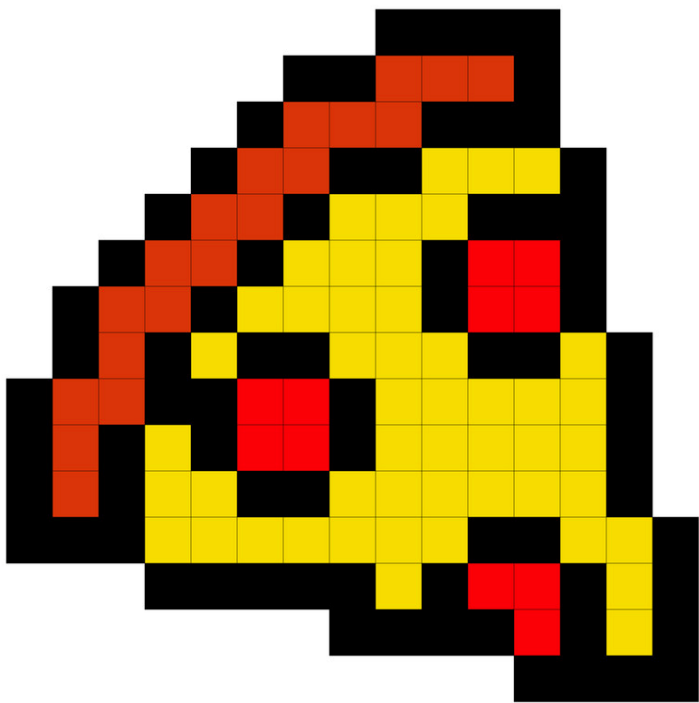
1. Choose one of the pixel emojis or pixel art pieces on the following pages and make a drawing on graph paper of it using coloured pencils.
