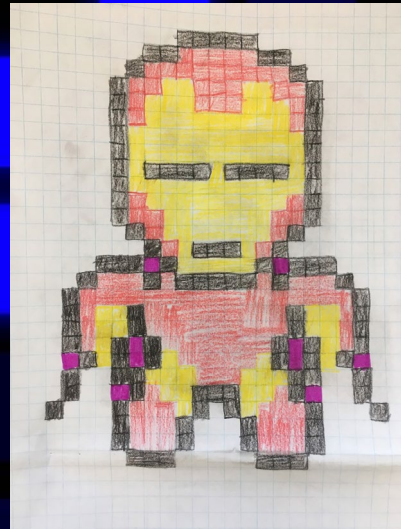
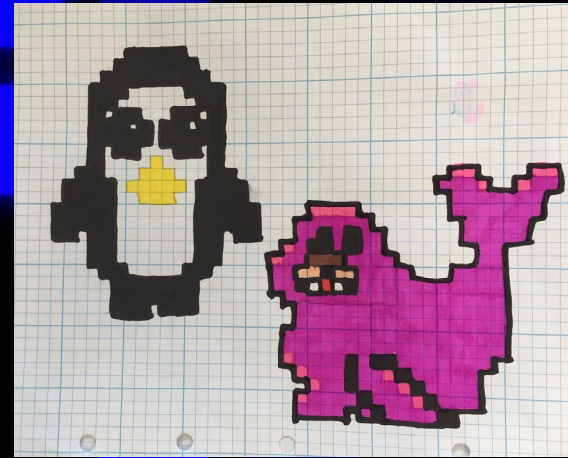
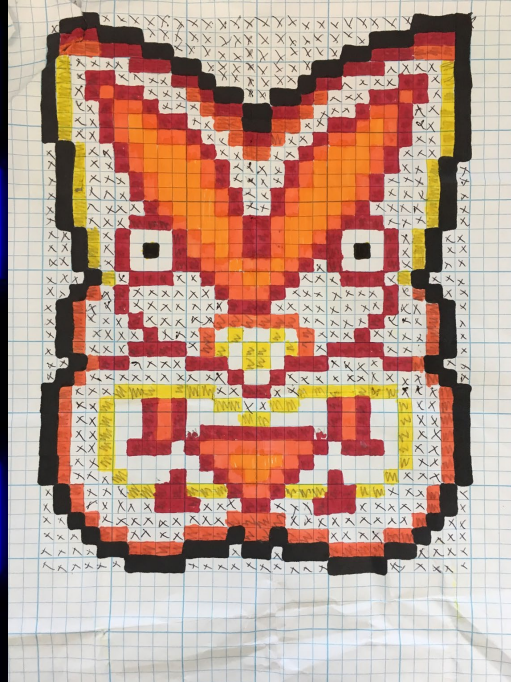

Concepts

- Start off by finding some pixel art images or an images you'd like to turn into a pixel image.
- Then do some drawing on maths/graph paper to get a feeling for what they might turn out like.
 - 3 to 4 drawings are required.

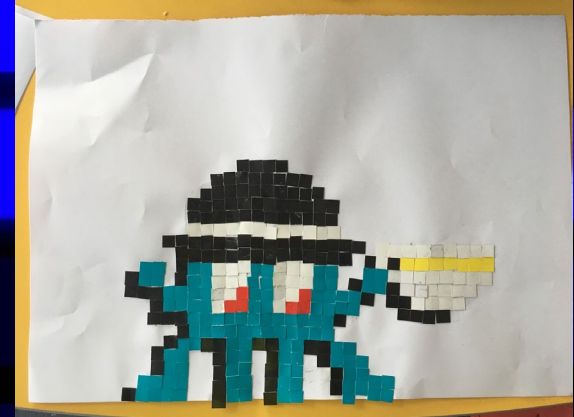


Your Concepts

 - Make it on an A3 piece of paper and glue the tiles down with PVA.



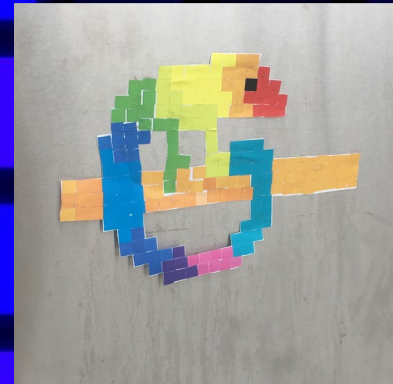
